The joint streaming rights between Disney+ and Max is the product of an unusual deal signed last year that allows Max to share streaming windows with Disney+ and Hulu for half the studios titles through the 2022 release year. Its good news for Avatar fans, who are less likely to need to subscribe to a new streamer in order to watch the sequel from home. It will also be available to stream for free on Amazon Prime Video, through the platforms 7-day free trial to Max. The Way of Water, which was released 13 years after the original Avatar, is set more than a decade after the events of the first film. The story follows the Sully family (Jake Sully, Neytiri and their kids) as they leave their homes to venture into unknown regions of Pandora. When an old threat resurfaces, Jake is once again forced to wage a battle against the humans. The film stars Sam Worthington, Zoe Saldaa, Sigourney Weaver, Stephen Lang, Cliff Curtis, Joel David Moore, CCH Pounder, Edie Falco, Jemaine Clement, Giovanni Ribisi and Kate Winslet. The film earned four Academy Award nominations and took home the Oscar for best visual effects.
